LBS CMSM Comparison Summary – Hamilton/ON

In the fiscal year of 2014-15 Ontario had 43,617 learners in LBS programs and Hamilton had 1,070 (2.45% of the provincial total). Although the CMSM data indicates no e-channel learners; data from Contact North suggests 97 learners were registered.
